Tamil Sangam Association of Poland Facilitates Swift Repatriation of Mr. Ragavan Subramanian Amidst Challenges

The Tamil Sangam Association of Poland (TSAP) has successfully completed the repatriation process for Mr. Ragavan Subramanian, who tragically passed away on December 7th, 2024, after being hospitalized in critical condition. This effort, completed within just two weeks, is a landmark achievement in Poland, demonstrating the association's commitment to supporting individuals and families during the most challenging times.

Swift Completion of Formalities

Mr.Ragavan Subramanian entered Poland in September 2024 for work. Following his untimely demise, TSAP immediately mobilized efforts to ensure that all processes, including obtaining medical documentation and a death certificate, were completed swiftly. By December 21st, 2024, his remains were sent to India, making this one of the fastest cases of repatriation in Poland's history.

Insurance Approvals Secured Through Persistent Efforts

TSAP worked relentlessly to secure approvals from the insurance company to cover all costs associated with the repatriation. This process involved navigating multiple hurdles, filing documentation, and engaging in numerous official correspondences. Thanks to these efforts, the entire repatriation expense, except for the road transportation from Cochin to his hometown, was covered by insurance.
